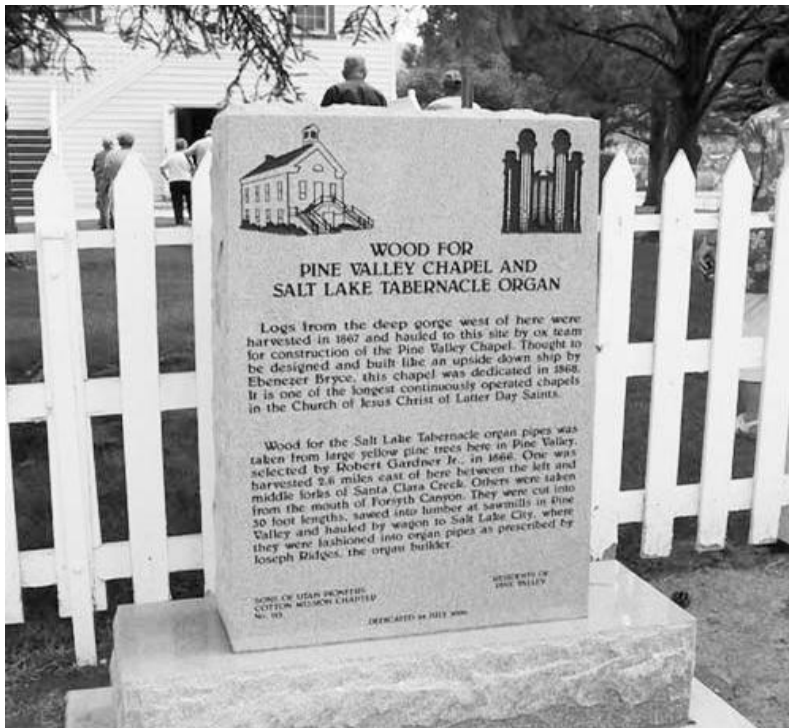


Tour Tip: Tour #1 visits the pastoral Pine Valley Chapel

PINE VALLEY CHAPEL

Built in 1868, the Pine Valley Chapel is the oldest continuously-used church building in Utah. In addition to being open for tours it is used weekly for LDS church services.



SUP Monument

In 2006 the Cotton Mission chapter of the Sons of Utah Pioneers placed a stone monument in front of the Pine Valley Chapel to commemorate the logging of wood from Pine Valley Mountain. In 1866 and 1867 logs were harvested from the nearby gorge to build both the Pine Valley Chapel and the organ pipes for the historic Salt Lake Tabernacle. 🌲
